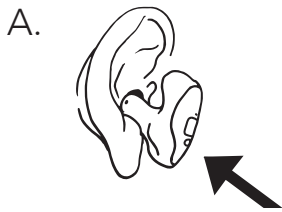

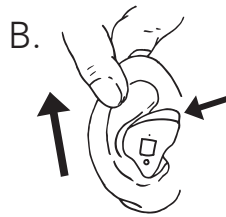
GETTING STARTED



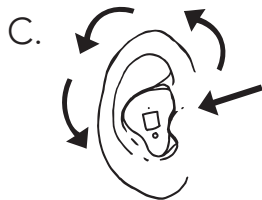
1. Your earplugs are custom made for your ears. In order to get the most out of them, it is important to insert them into your ears properly. It is best to start with our tutorial video at <https://alclr.co/insertvideo> or you can scan the QR code.



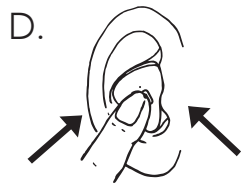
A. Place the earplug or hearing protection into your ear with the top facing towards the front.



B. Pull out on the top of your ear and rotate the earplug backwards.



C. Continue to rotate the earplug back, "screwing" it into your ear until it seats.



D. Press firmly on the earplug to ensure a good seal.

2. Your earplugs should not be painful to wear, but might cause slight discomfort for a period of time as your ears get used to wearing them.
3. In order to properly protect your hearing, you should have a good seal on your hearing protection. While it is nearly impossible to have a perfect seal 100% of the time, they should seal the majority of the time you are using them.
4. There are a couple of ways to tell which earplug is left and which is right.

ALCLAIR EXP and ACRYLIC HEARING PROTECTION
The back of the hearing protection will have a colored name with red for right and blue for left.

SILICONE EARPLUGS: Look on the bottom of the earplug, the red dot indicates the right earplug.

EXP PRO PROGRAM MODES

The EXP PRO has 4 modes so you can get exactly the right sound for your pursuit.

MODE 1

Flat EQ Profile: This mode offers a balanced sound with minimal enhancement. It is a neutral setting and a great starting point, keeping all frequencies evenly represented for a natural listening experience.

MODE 2

High-Frequency Boost: This mode enhances the higher frequencies, giving you greater sensitivity to sounds like bird vocalizations and human conversations. Everything is a bit clearer and crisper, especially in the upper range.

MODE 3

High Boost + Low Cut: In this mode, you get the same high-frequency boost as in Mode 2 but with a cut in the lower frequencies. This profile is perfect for filtering out unnecessary bass sounds so you can focus on important noises like bird wings, vocalizations, and human voices. This is a great profile for those who have been affected by moderate hearing loss

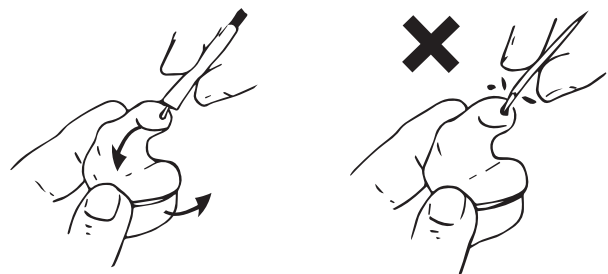
MODE 4

Upland Hunting Preset: Designed with input from upland hunters, this mode minimizes the sounds of rustling brush and wind noise while enhancing the sounds of birds. It is ideal for pinpointing bird locations during hunts while offering maximum hearing protection from gunshots.

CARING FOR YOUR HEARING PROTECTION

PROTECT & CLEAN

When done using your hearing protection, clean them and store them in their case. Do not use a toothpick or other sharp object to clean your earplugs or hearing protection. Doing so may cause damage.



WAX

The vast majority of repairs that we see are due to wax buildup in the tubes. If your Alclair EXP sound uneven or start to lose some frequencies, please contact us so that we can get them repaired.

DROPS

The Alclair EXP uses high quality components but they are still susceptible to physical damage from collision. Please protect your Alclair EXP from falls and impact.

STORAGE

Keep your hearing protection in the case when you are not using them. When placing your hearing protection or earplugs in a hard shell case, make sure they are not overlapping or stacked before closing the lid.

SURE-FIT GUARANTEE

Your earplugs are based on the impressions you sent us. Most of the time, they will fit great but there is a chance that adjustments will need to be made for a proper fit. Please let us know as soon as possible if you have fit issues so that we can make adjustments.

TROUBLESHOOTING AND MAINTENANCE

I am getting feedback.

Feedback usually occurs if you don't have a good seal or are using them too loud. Make sure your Alclair EXP is fully in your ear and you have a good seal. If you continue to experience feedback, contact us and we will work with you on the fit/seal.

BATTERY (ALCLAIR EXP ONLY)

Make sure to open the battery door when you store your EXP earplugs. This will prolong the battery life.

To replace the batteries on your Alclair EXP, open the door on the face plate by gently pulling on the rounded tab. The door will swing open to expose the batteries for replacement.

NOTE: Higher volumes will decrease battery life.

REPAIR

If you are experiencing problems with your hearing protection, please contact us. Repairs take roughly 7-20 business days to complete depending on the repair. All repairs require an RMA number. Please contact us to set up the repair.
